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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 12 percent very short, 36 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent very short, 46 percent short, and 46 percent adequate.
