According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 13, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 15 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 18 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus.
