According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 26, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 33 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 27 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
