According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 11, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 10 percent very short, 41 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 13 percent very short, 42 percent short, 44 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
