According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 30, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 34 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 20 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
