According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 20, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 14 percent very short, 21 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 12 percent very short, 43 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
