According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 27, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 11 percent very short, 25 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent very short, 44 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
