According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 4, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 15 percent short, 70 percent adequate, and 14 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 38 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus.
