According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, May 25, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 76 percent adequate, and 21 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 9 percent short, 89 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
