Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up Slightly

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 241 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 11, 2023, up slightly from a year ago. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 79.2 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Hatcheries in Alabama set 34.9 million eggs during the week ending March 11, 2023, up slightly from a year ago. Hatcheries in Georgia set 35.5 million eggs during the same week, up slightly from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down Slightly

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 186 million chicks for meat production during the week ending March 11, 2023, down slightly from a year ago. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 7, 2023 through March 11, 2023 for the United States were 1.87 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Broiler growers in Alabama placed 24.8 million chicks for meat production during the week ending March 11, 2023, down 3 percent from a year ago. Placements in Georgia totaled 27.5 million chicks, up 10 percent from a year ago.
