

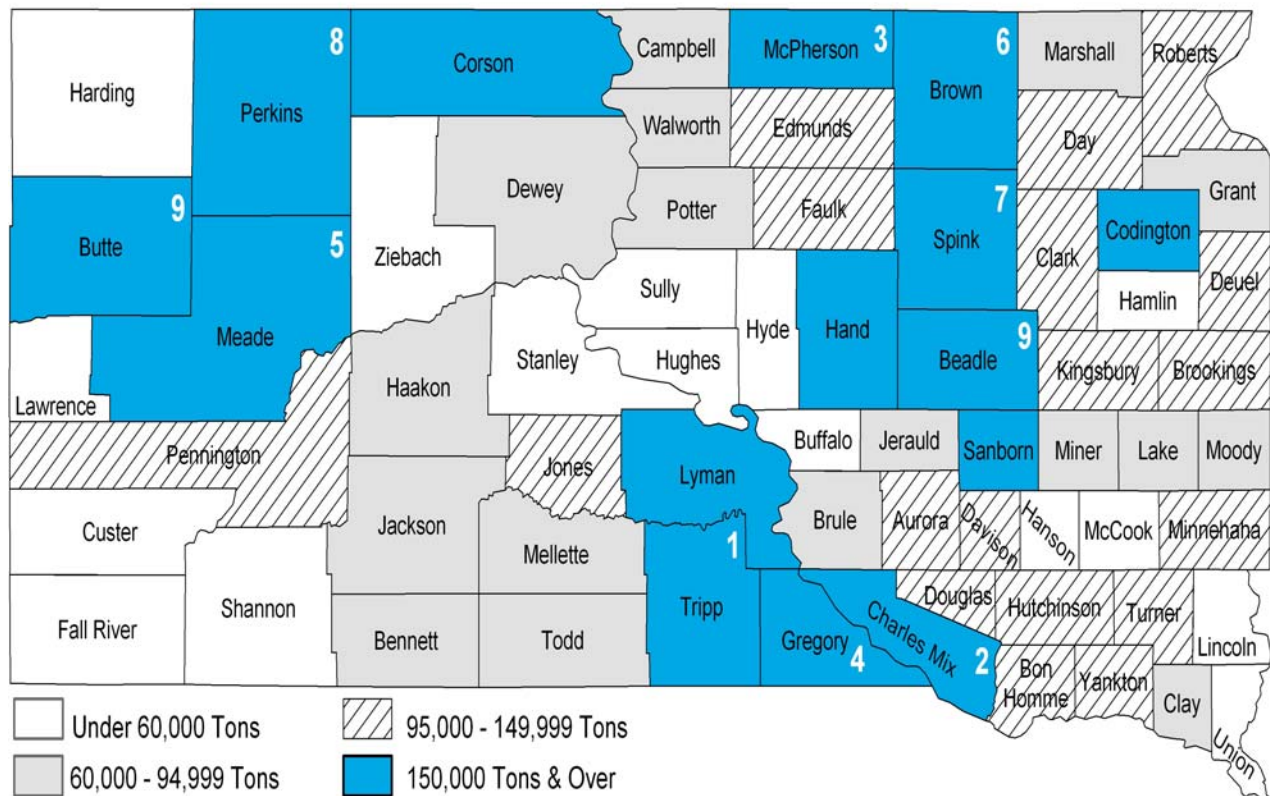

### ALL HAY PRODUCTION, SOUTH DAKOTA, 2003 (RANKING OF TOP TEN COUNTIES SHOWN)



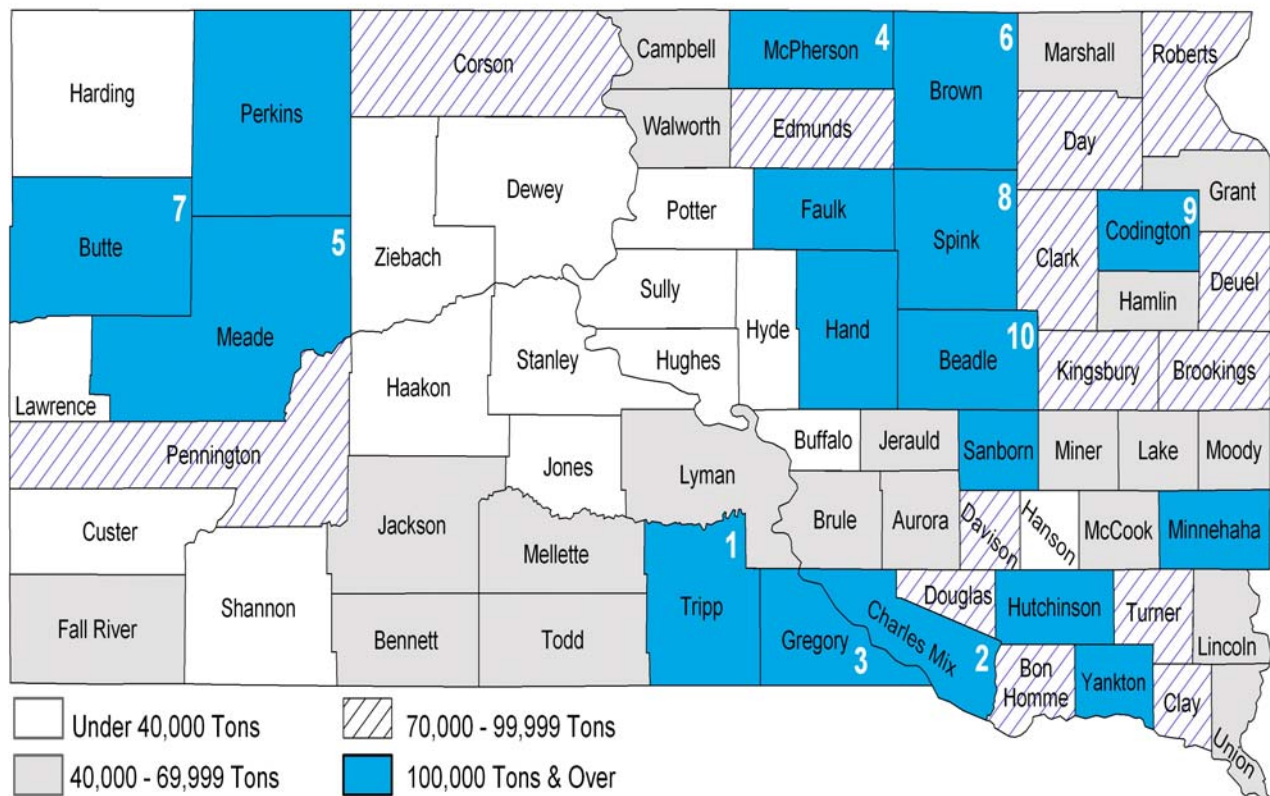
