

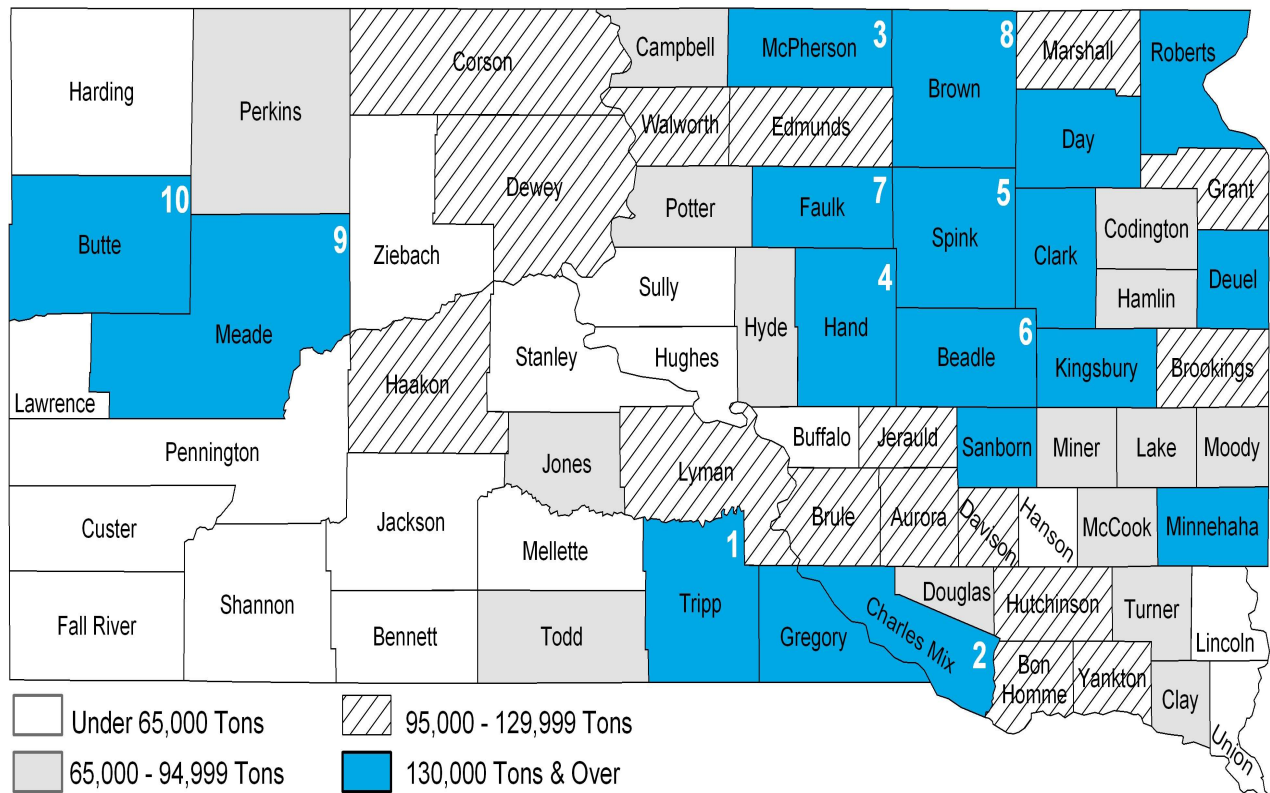

ALL HAY PRODUCTION, SOUTH DAKOTA, 2004 (RANKING OF TOP TEN COUNTIES SHOWN)



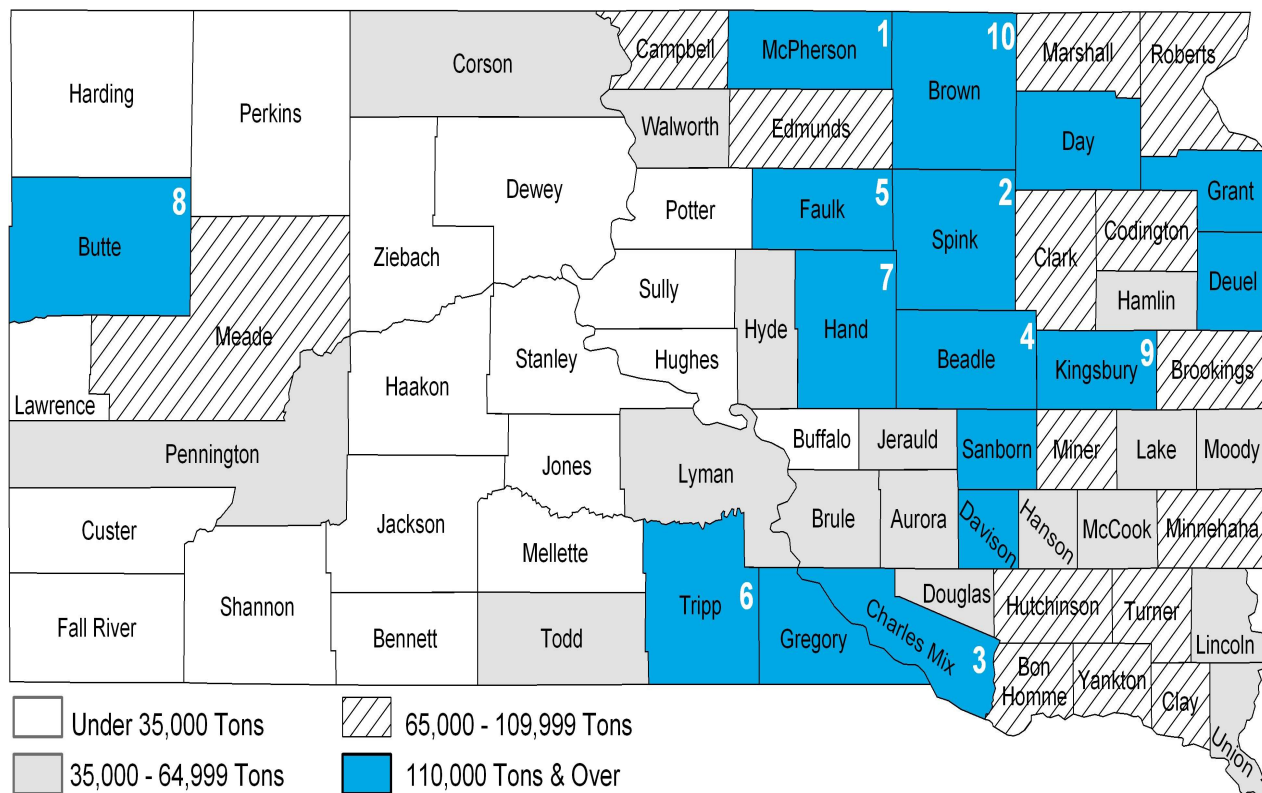
