SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. February 26, 2018 – For the month of February 2018, topsoil moisture supplies rated 21 percent very short, 42 short, 37 adequate, and 0 surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 22 percent very short, 41 short, 37 adequate, and 0 surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 4 percent very poor, 28 poor, 49 fair, 19 good, and 0 excellent.

The next monthly report (for March) will be issued March 26, 2018. Weekly reports will begin April 2nd for the 2018 season.
