SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. March 3, 2025 - For the week ending March 2, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 43% very short, 40% short, 17% adequate, and 0% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 40% very short, 43% short, 17% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 10% very poor, 32% poor, 42% fair, 16% good, and 0% excellent.

The next report will be issued March 31, 2025.
