SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. March 31, 2025 - For the week ending March 30, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 52% very short, 37% short, 11% adequate, and 0% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 51% very short, 38% short, 11% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 17% very poor, 33% poor, 35% fair, 15% good, and 0% excellent.

Weekly reports will begin April 7th for the 2025 season.
