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SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 9%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. January 20, 2023 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 210,000 cattle on feed on January 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 9% from last year.

Placements during December totaled 34,000 head, down 21% from 2021.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of December totaled 40,000 head, down 11% from last year.

Other disappearance during December totaled 4,000 head, up 1,000 head from last year.
