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SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 9%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. February 24, 2023 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 215,000 cattle on feed on February 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 9% from last year.

Placements during January totaled 40,000 head, up 8% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of January totaled 33,000 head, up 10% from last year.

Other disappearance during January totaled 2,000 head, unchanged from last year.
