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SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 4%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. April 21, 2023 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 220,000 cattle on feed on April 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 4% from last year.

Placements during March totaled 44,000 head, up 26% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of March totaled 37,000 head, unchanged from last year.

Other disappearance during March totaled 2,000 head, down 1,000 head from last year.
