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SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED UP 6%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. July 21, 2023 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 180,000 cattle on feed on July 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 6% from last year.

Placements during June totaled 22,000 head, unchanged from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of June totaled 40,000 head, down 7% from last year.

Other disappearance during June totaled 2,000 head, down 2,000 head from last year.
