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SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 3%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. September 22, 2023 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 170,000 cattle on feed on September 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was down 3% from last year.

Placements during August totaled 35,000 head, down 19% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of August totaled 34,000 head, up 10% from last year.

Other disappearance during August totaled 1,000 head, down 1,000 head from last year.
