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SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED UP 5%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. November 17, 2023 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 220,000 cattle on feed on November 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 5% from last year.

Placements during October totaled 69,000 head, down 4% from 2022.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of October totaled 33,000 head, down 27% from last year.

Other disappearance during October totaled 1,000 head, down 1,000 head from last year.
