Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.68 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 1, down 3 percent from the week prior, but up 1 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 1, was 4.60 million, up 12 percent from the previous week and up 32 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 1, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 1, was 14.6 million, up 1 percent from the previous week but down 1 percent from the previous year.
