Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.76 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 26, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 26, was 4.46 million, up 10 percent from the previous week and up 28 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 26, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 26, was 5.6 million, up 5 percent from the previous week, but down 62 percent from the previous year.
