Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.66 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 5, down 1 percent from the week prior but 1 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 5, was 4.26 million, down 5 percent from the previous week but up 22 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 5, up slightly from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 5, was 5.6 million, down slightly from the previous week and down 62 percent from the previous year.
