Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.60 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 16, up 1 percent from the week prior and 1 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 16, down slightly from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 16, was 5.10 million, down 4 percent from the previous week but up 14 percent from the previous year.
