Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 11, down 2 percent from the week prior but 3 percent down the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 11, was 4.89 million, up 9 percent from the previous week and up 7 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 11, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 11, was 14.7 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and down 2 percent from the previous year.
