Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.77 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 18, up 1 percent from the week prior and 3 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 18, was 5.09 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 40 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 18, down 2 percent from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 18, was 14.8 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
