Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.72 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 9, down slightly from the week prior but up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 9, was 4.23 million, down 2 percent from the previous week and up 1 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 9, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 9, was 14.8 million, down 3 percent from the previous week but up 3 percent from the previous year.
