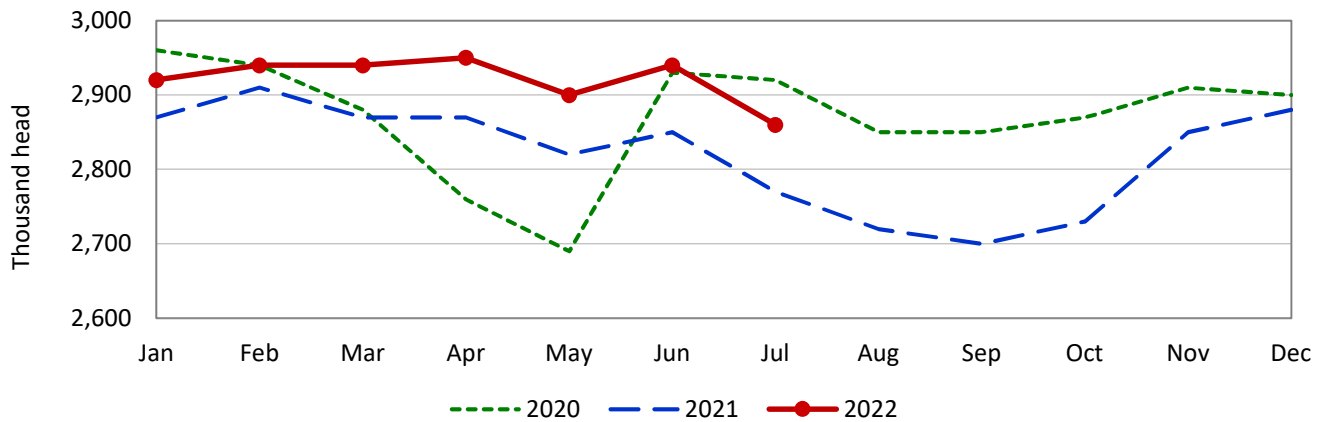

This report contains results from the July 2022 Cattle on Feed Survey collected during the first two weeks of July. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next monthly survey will be made available on August 19, 2022.

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in **Texas** feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 2.86 million head on July 1, 2022, up 3 percent from a year ago. Producers placed 390 thousand head in commercial feedlots during June, up 3 percent from a year ago. Texas commercial feeders marketed 460 thousand head during June, up 2 percent from 2021.

On July 1, there were 2.55 million head of cattle and calves on feed in the Northern High Plains, 89 percent of the state's total. The number on feed across the area was up 4 percent from last year but down 3 percent from the June 1 total. June placements in the Northern High Plains totaled 345 thousand head, down 17 percent from the May total. Marketings were up 14 percent from last month at 406 thousand head.

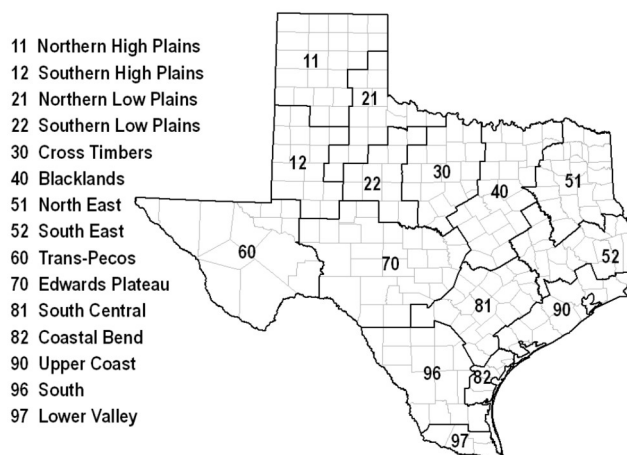

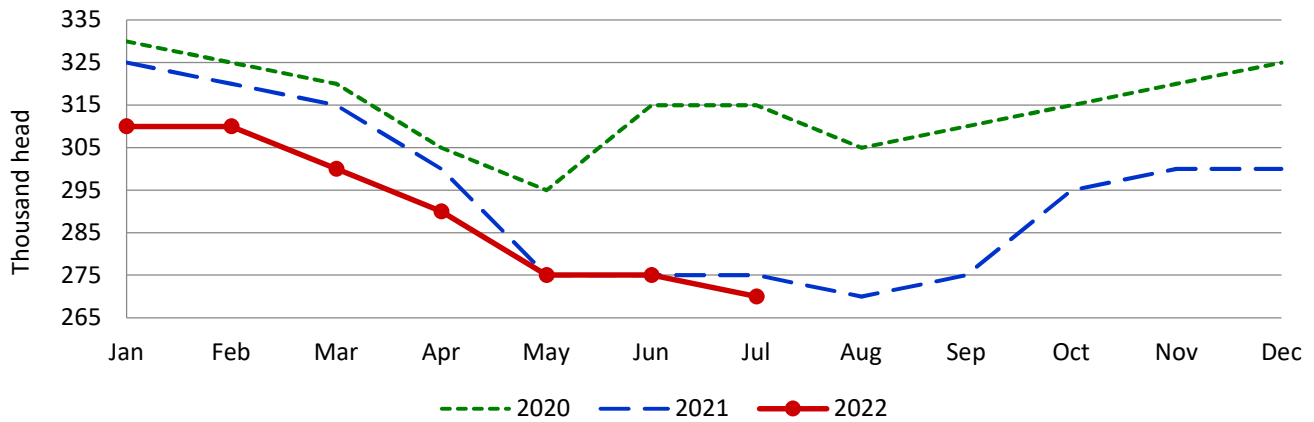
¹ Cattle and calves on feed are animals for slaughter market being fed a ration of grain or other concentrates and are expected to produce a carcass that will grade select or better.

² Included death losses, movement from feedlots to pasture and shipments to other feedlots for further feeding.



Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in **Oklahoma** feedlots with capacity of 1,000 head or more totaled 270 thousand head on July 1, 2022, down 2 percent from a year ago. Producers placed 41 thousand head in commercial feedlots during June, down 24 percent from a year ago. Oklahoma commercial feeders marketed 45 thousand head during June, down 15 percent from 2021. Other disappearance during June totaled 1 thousand head, unchanged from a year ago.
