

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of June. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on September 30, 2022.

Oklahoma stocks of wheat in all positions on June 1 totaled 77.8 million bushels, up 12 percent from the 2021 level of 69.7 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 76.4 million bushels, were 12 percent higher than June 1, 2021.


Texas stocks of wheat in all positions on June 1, at 24.7 million bushels, were down 57 percent from the 2021 level of 57.4 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 24.0 million bushels, were 57 percent lower than June 1, 2021.

Quarterly Wheat Stocks All Positions




Texas off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 19.7 million bushels. On-farm stocks for sorghum totaled 200 thousand bushels on June 1, 2022.

Texas off-farm corn stocks, at 29.9 million bushels, were down 32 percent from last year. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.



Oklahoma off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 3.25 million bushels, up 231 percent June 1, 2021. On-farm stocks for sorghum are not published for the state.

Oklahoma off-farm corn stocks, at 4.80 million bushels, were up 20 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks for corn are not published for the state.

U.S. Highlights: Total stocks of corn in the United States on June 1, 2022 were 4.35 billion bushels, 6 percent higher than June 1, 2021. All wheat stocks were estimated at 660 million bushels in all positions, down 22 percent from last June. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 121 million bushels, 195 percent above June 1, 2021. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 971 million bushels, up 26 percent from last year.
