**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.54 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 14, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 16.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 14, down 7 percent from the week prior and down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 14, was 5.33 million, up 24 percent from the previous week and up 34 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 14, was 14.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down slightly from the previous year.
