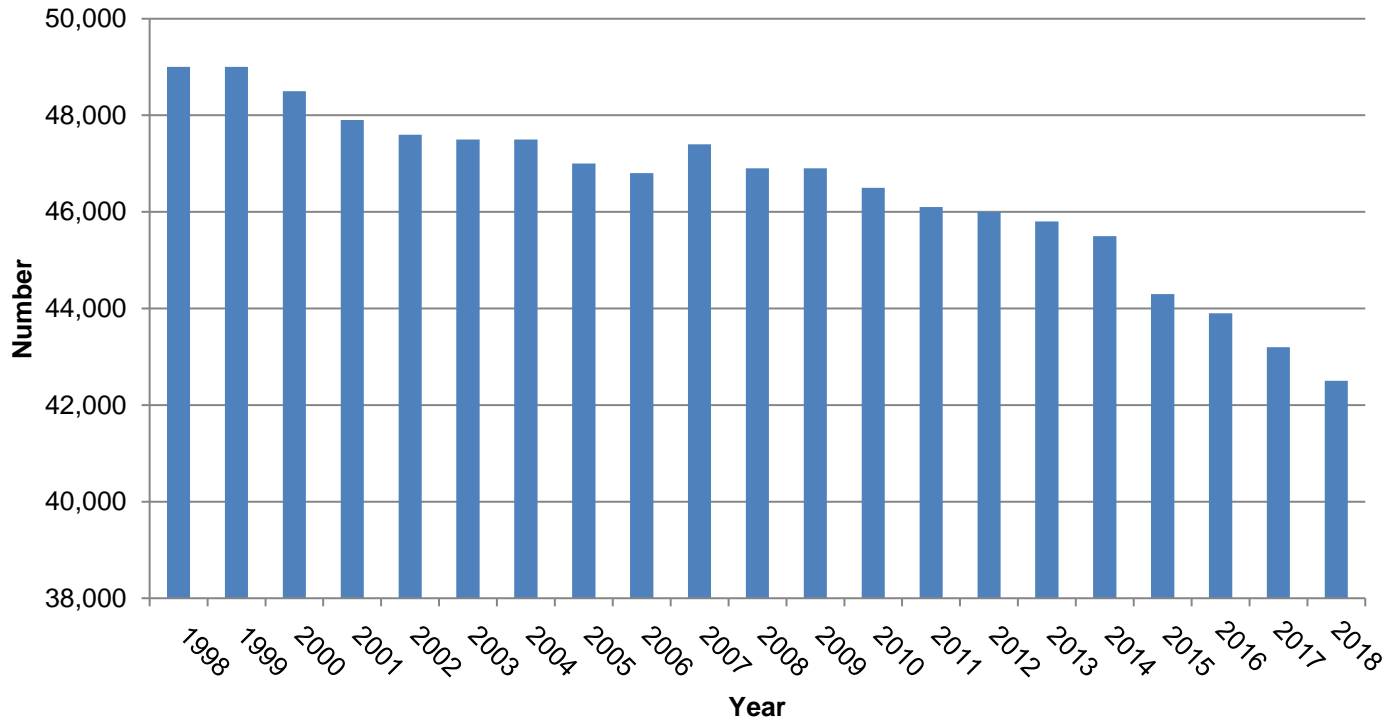

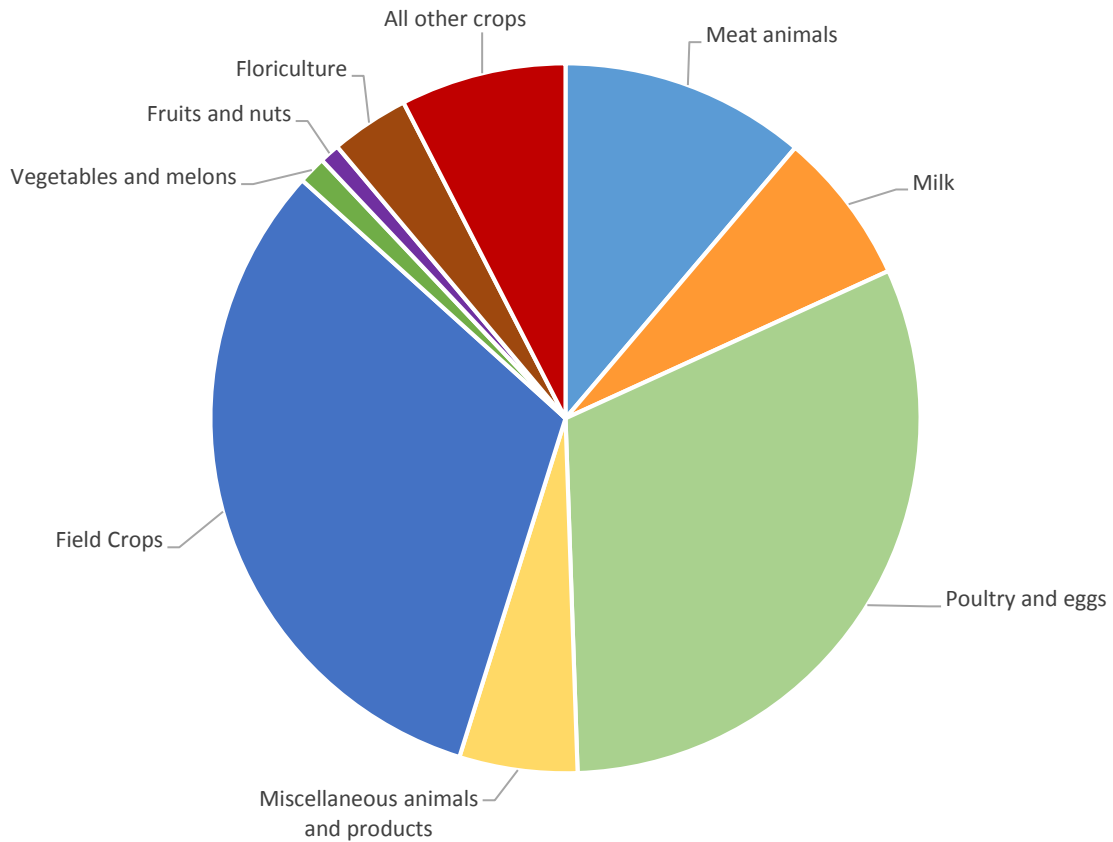
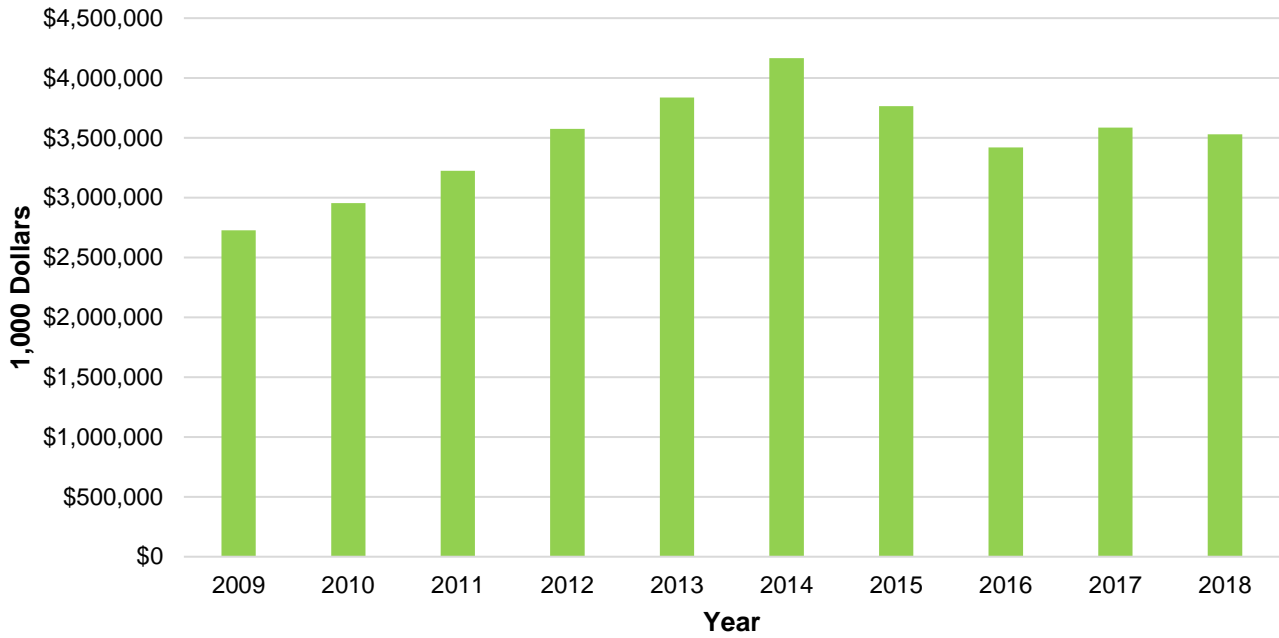

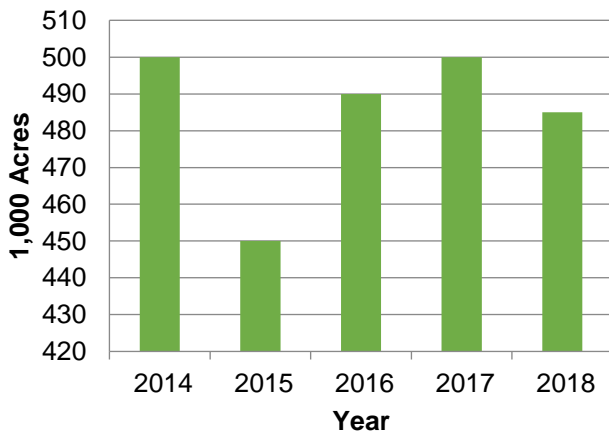

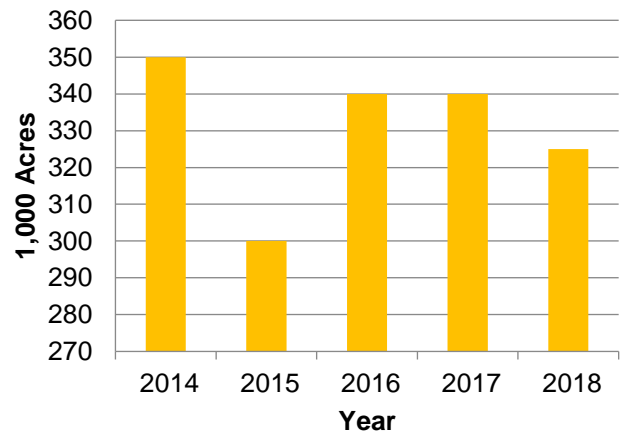

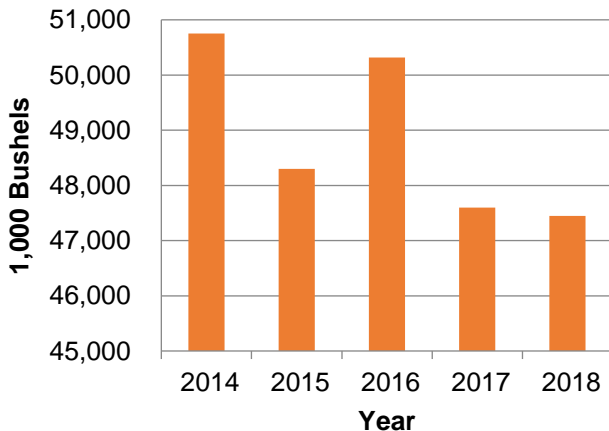
**Corn: Acres Planted, Virginia: 2014-2018**



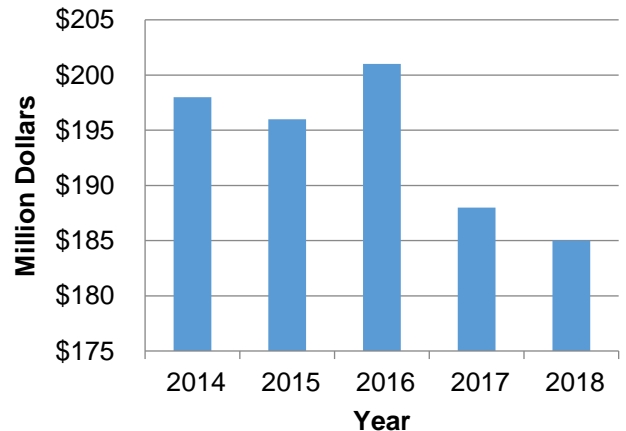
**Corn: Acres Harvested for Grain, Virginia: 2014-2018**

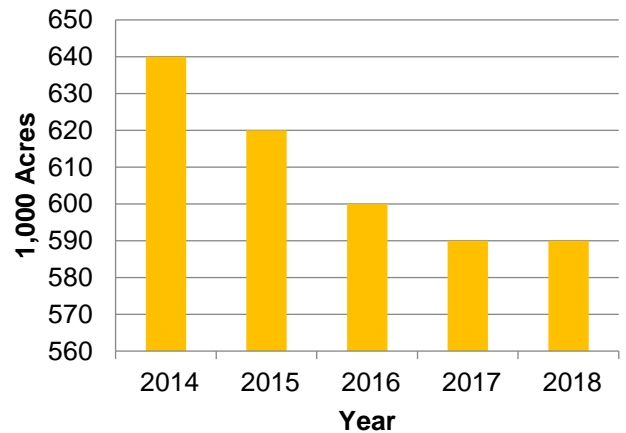

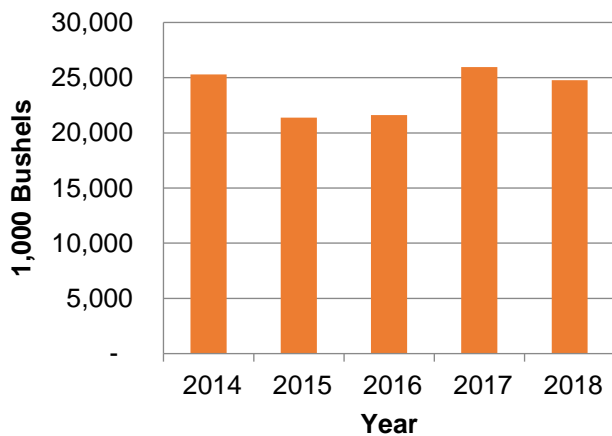
**Soybeans: Acres Planted, Virginia: 2014-2018**



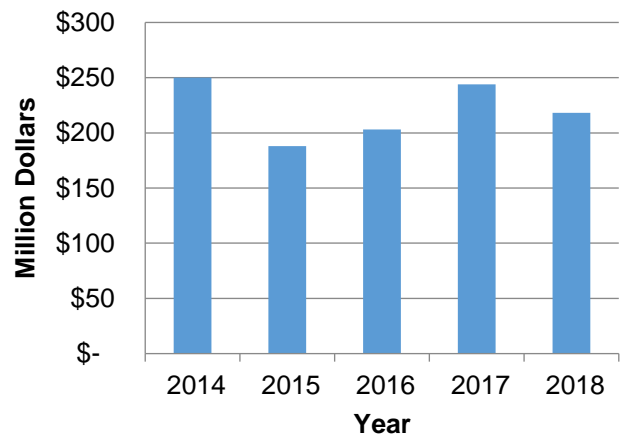
**Soybeans: Acres Harvested, Virginia: 2014-2018**

**Soybeans: Value of Production, Virginia: 2014-2018**



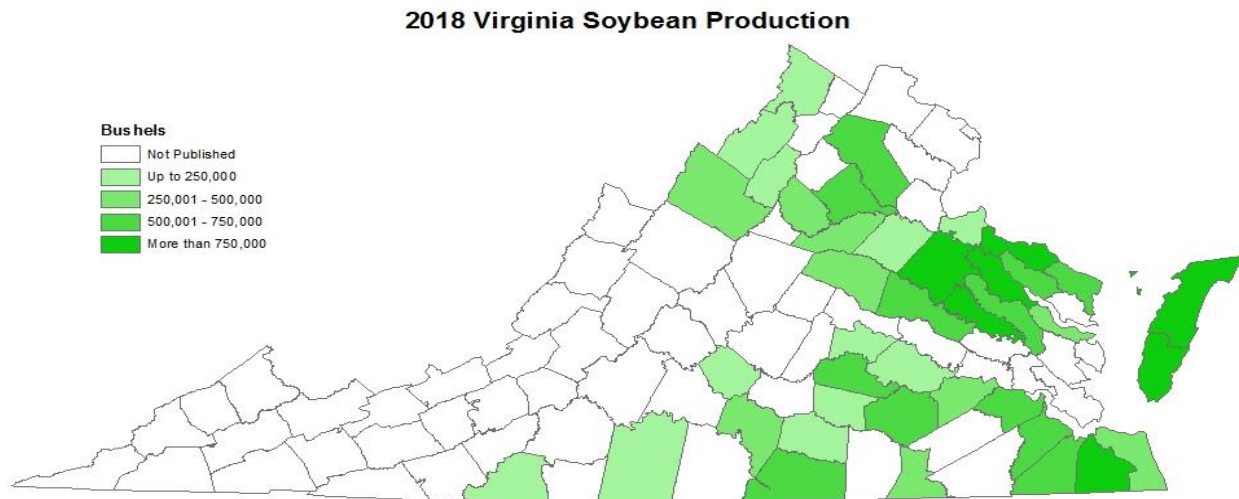

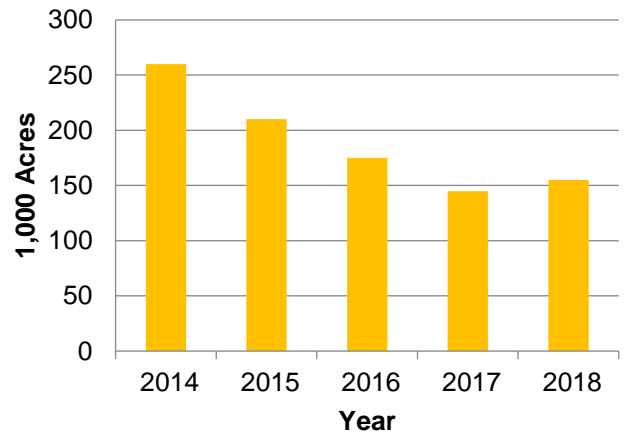

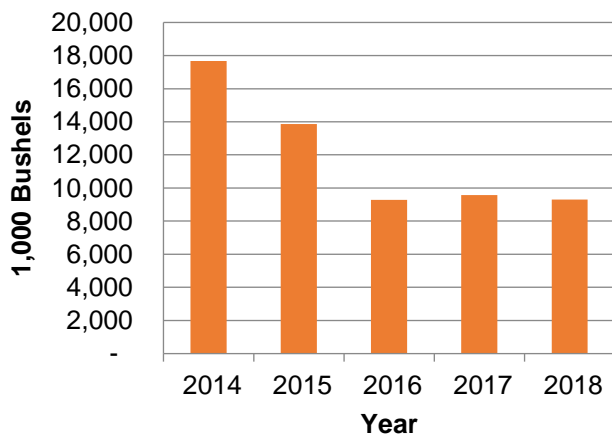
**Winter Wheat: Acres Planted, Virginia: 2014-2018**



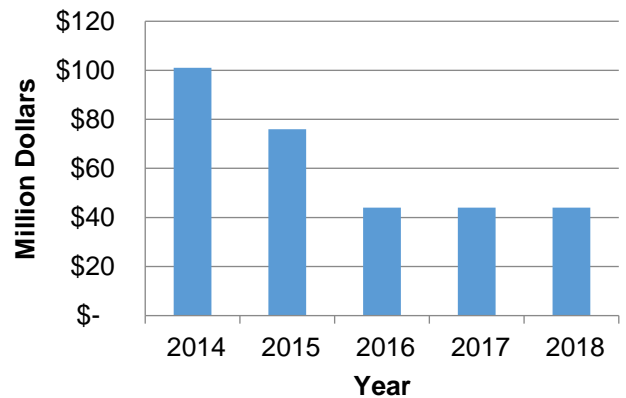
**Winter Wheat: Acres Harvested, Virginia: 2014-2018**

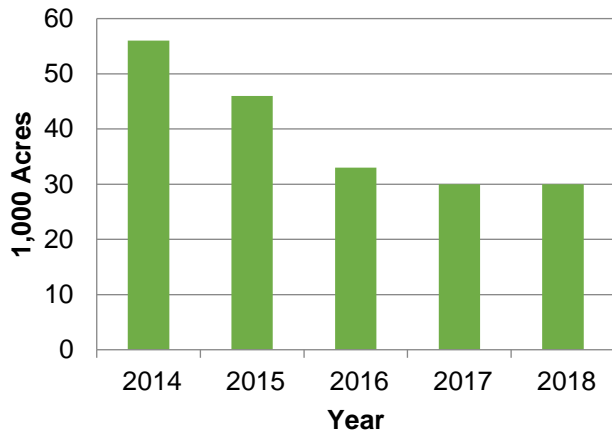

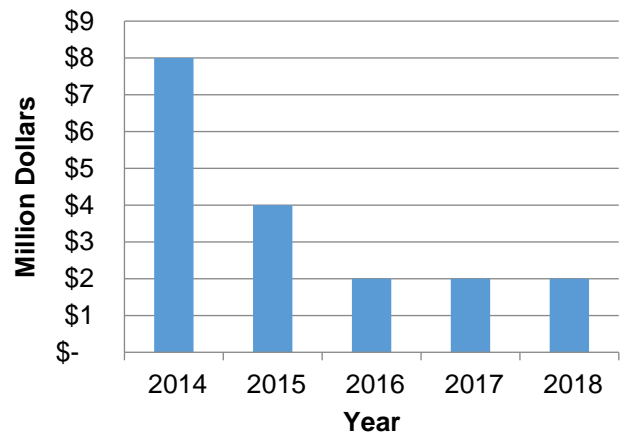
**Barley: Acres Harvested, Virginia: 2014-2018**

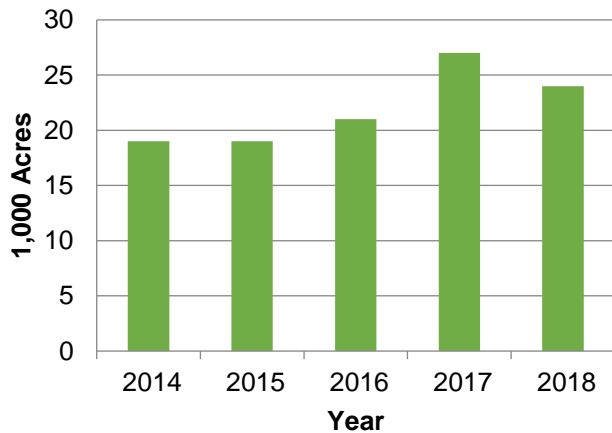

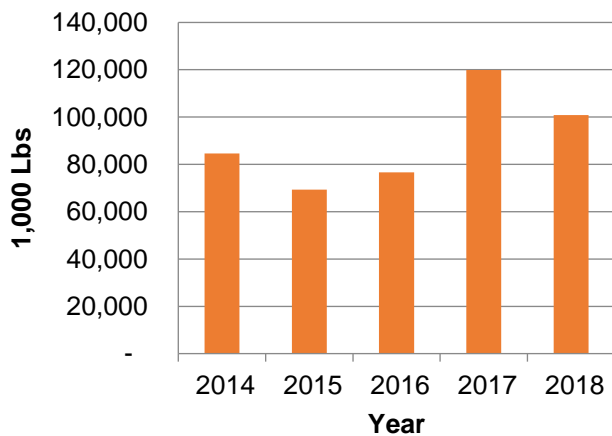

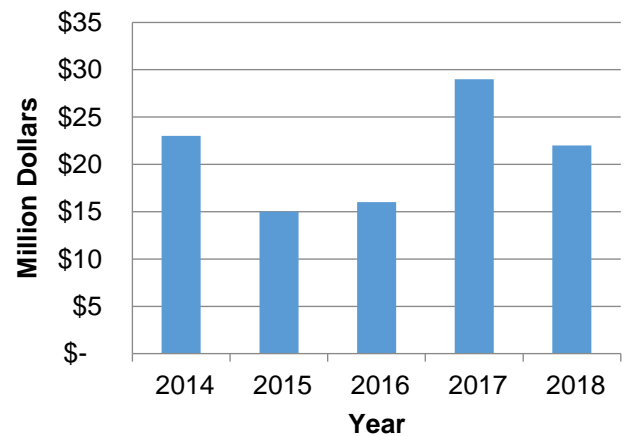

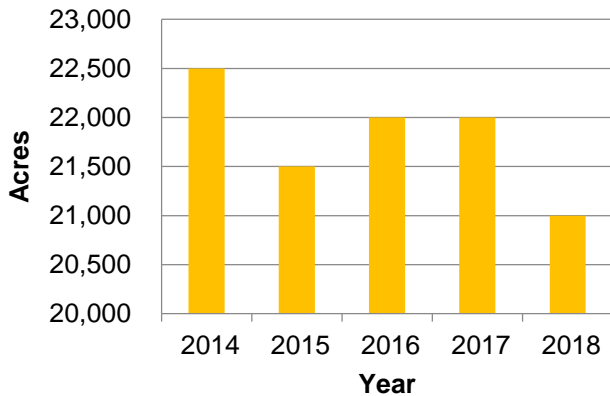

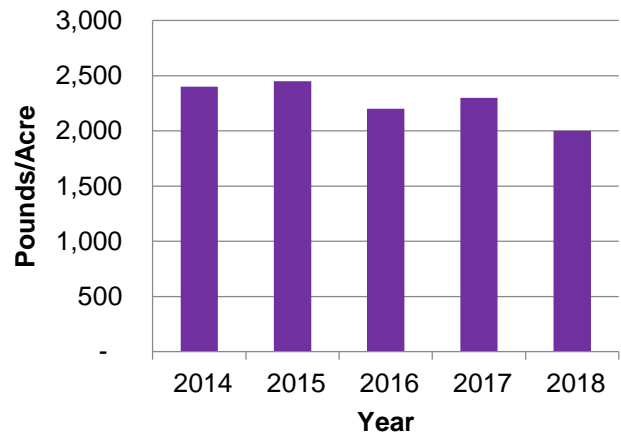

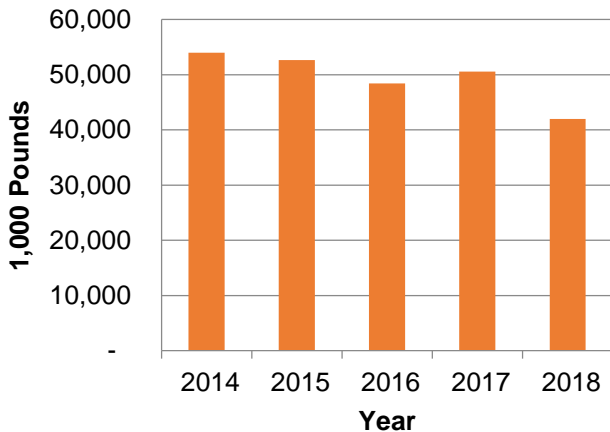
**Tobacco, Flue-cured: Acres Harvested, Virginia: 2014-2018**



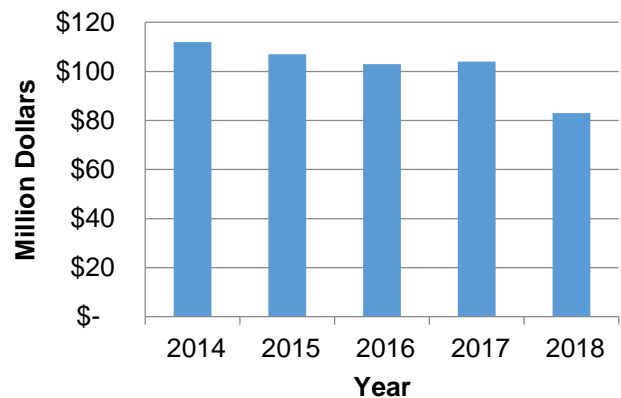
**Tobacco, Flue-cured: Yield, Virginia: 2014-2018**

**Tobacco, Flue-cured: Value of Production, Virginia: 2014-2018**

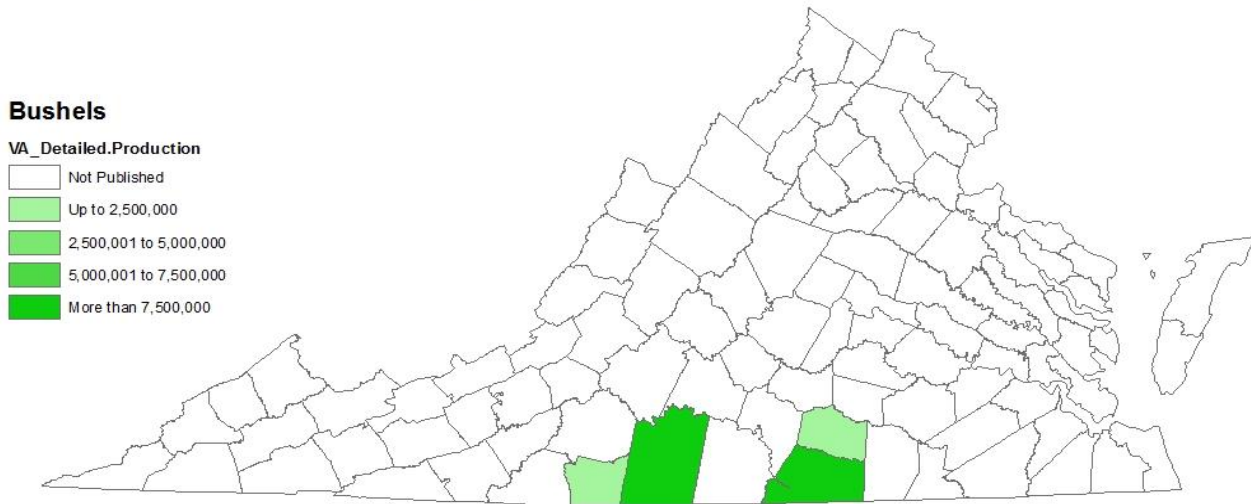

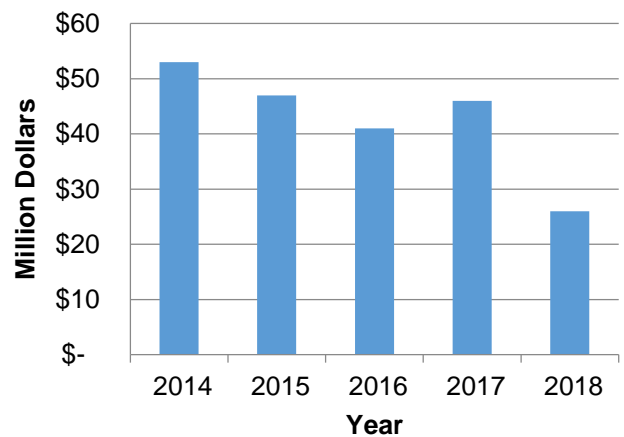

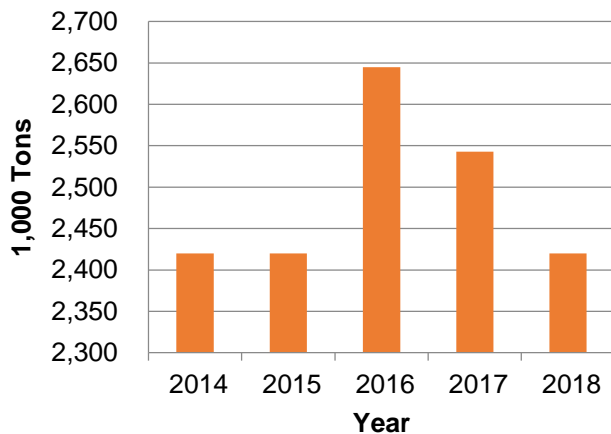
**Hay, Alfalfa: Production, Virginia: 2014-2018**



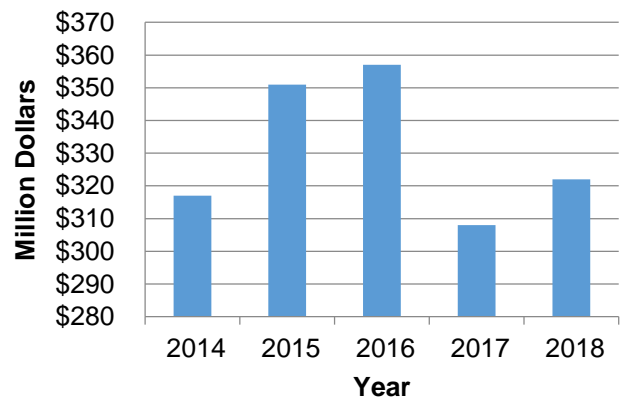
**Hay, Alfalfa: Value of Production, Virginia: 2014-2018**



**Hay, All Other: Production, Virginia: 2014-2018**



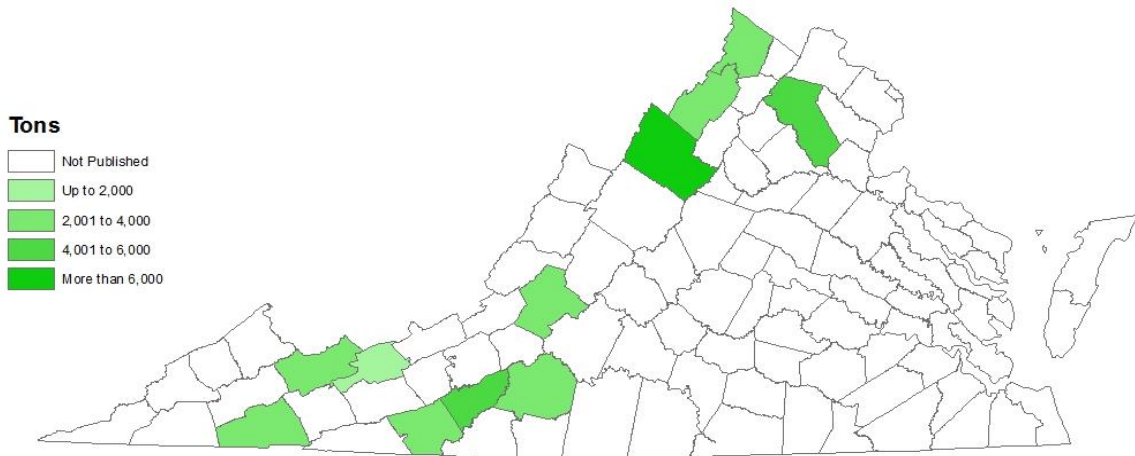

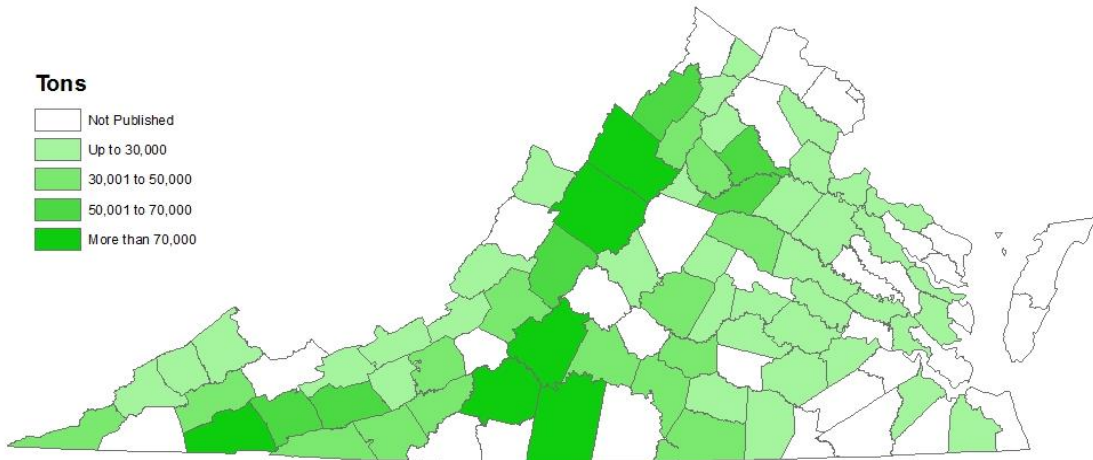

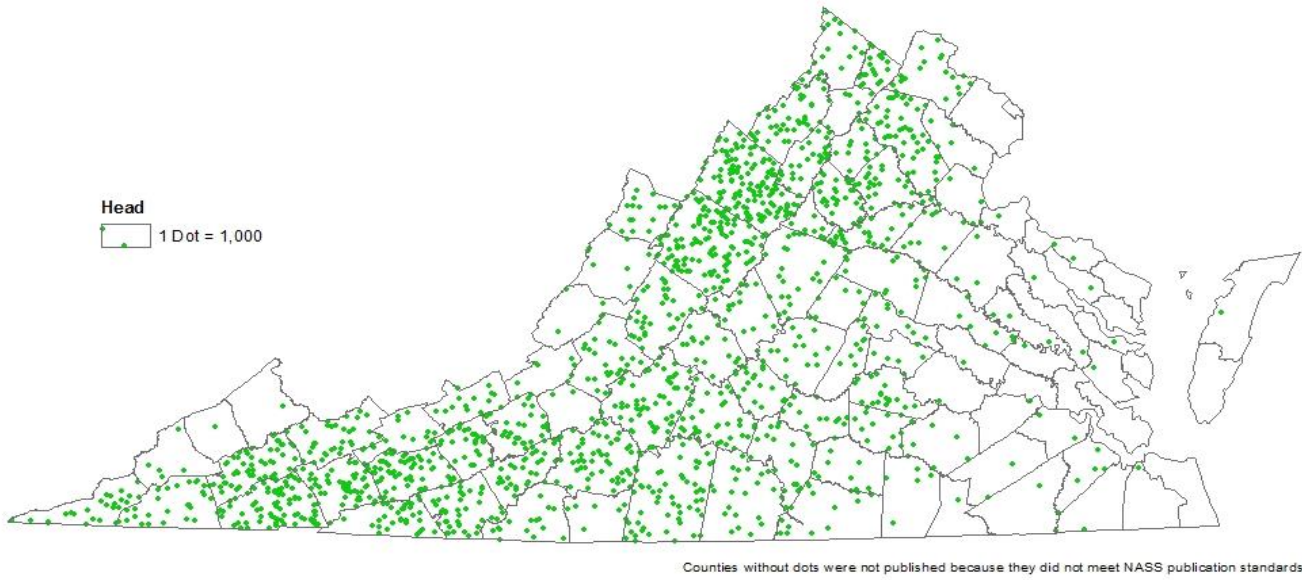
