<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.3. Weather conditions were mostly cool and dry, slowing some crop progress. High average temperatures were mostly in the lower 70s, and low average temperatures were mostly in the 40s. There are abnormally dry and moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included planting crops and looking for frost damage on fruit.
