# **Crop Progress and Condition**



#### Released: May 16, 2022

<u>Agricultural News</u>: Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.0. Weather conditions were mostly cool and dry. High average temperatures were mostly in the upper 70s, and low average temperatures were in the 50s. There are abnormally dry and moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included planting crops and checking hay quality. Cooler temperatures have slowed some seedling growth.




