

<u>Agricultural News</u>: Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.1. Weather conditions were mostly warm and dry. High average temperatures were in the upper 80s, and low average temperatures were mostly in the 60s. There are abnormally dry and moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included planting crops and making hay. High fertilizer and fuel prices are affecting farming decisions.






CORN PLANTED for week ending 5/22/22
