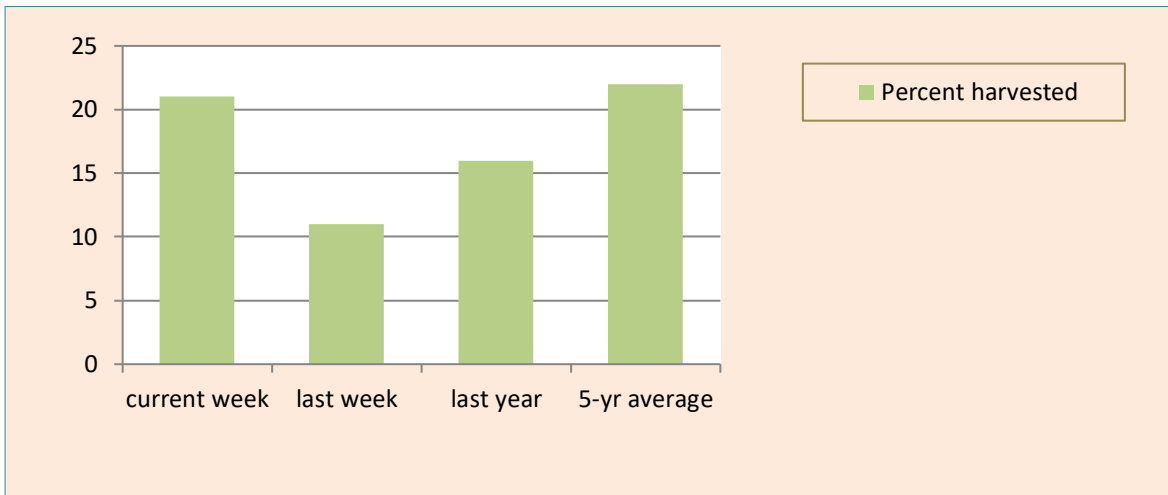

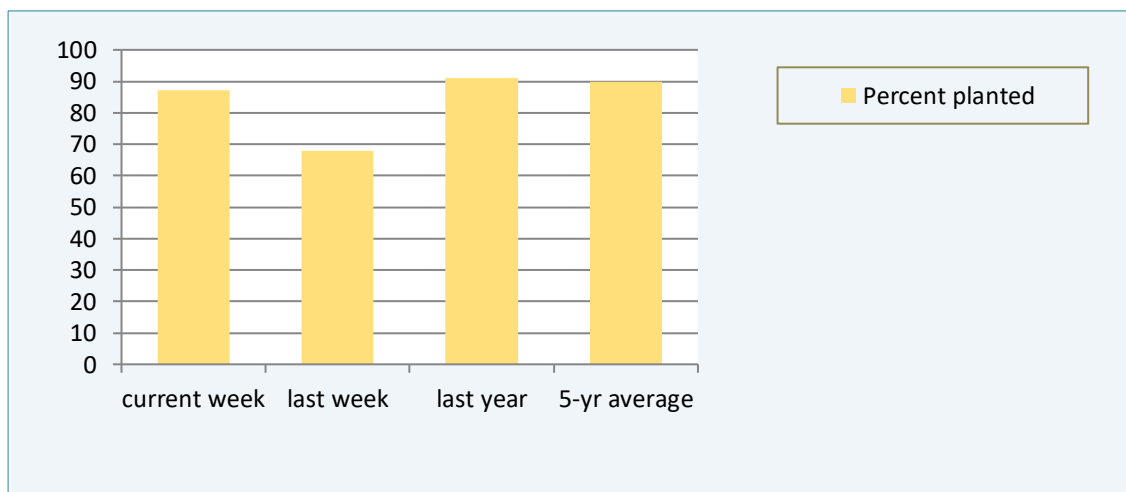

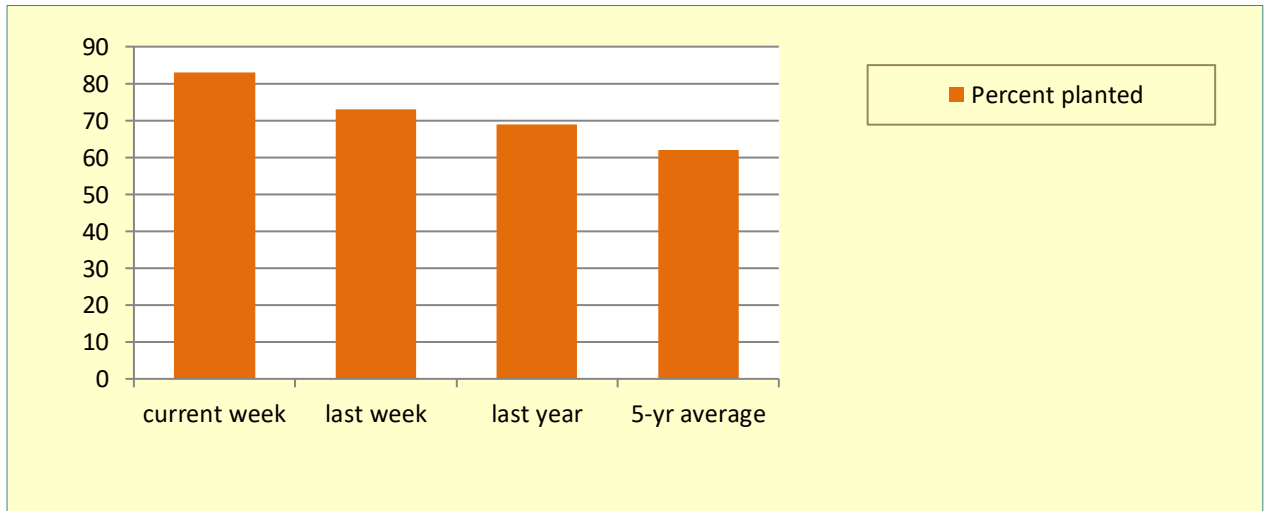
BARLEY HARVESTED FOR GRAIN for week ending 6/5/22
