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<u>Agricultural News</u>: Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.1. Weather conditions were warm with average high temperatures mostly in the upper 80s. Precipitation was limited. Some fields are showing signs of drought stress. There are some areas of abnormally dry and moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included harvesting corn for silage and harvesting tobacco.






APPLES HARVESTED for week ending 9/04/22
