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<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 4.5. Weather conditions were warm with average high temperatures mostly in the lower 80s. Average lows were mostly in the upper 60s. Precipitation was up from the previous week, helping some crops and pastures. Spotty showers brought some heavy rain, but some areas remain dry. There are abnormally dry and moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included fall calving, harvesting corn for grain and silage, and harvesting tobacco.










COTTON BOLLS OPENING for week ending 9/11/22
