<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.8. Weather conditions were cool and dry. Average high temperatures were mostly in the upper 60s. Average lows were mostly in the 40s. Some areas had frost. There are abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included planting small grains and harvesting corn, soybeans, and peanuts.






APPLES HARVESTED for week ending 10/09/22
