
<u>Agricultural News</u>: Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.2. Weather conditions were cool with scattered rain. Farmers are waiting for some fields to dry down before harvesting. Average high temperatures were mostly in the upper 40s. Average lows were mostly in the 30s. There are abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included planting small grains and harvesting soybeans.




COTTON HARVESTED for week ending 11/20/22
