



Crop Progress and Condition



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
Agricultural News: This is the last weekly Virginia Crop Weather Bulletin of the year. Monthly reports will be published during the winter months. We would like to thank our federal, state and county cooperative partners for their valuable help in providing the information that makes this publication possible. Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.5. Weather conditions were warmer with scattered rain. Harvest was delayed in some areas with heavier rain. Average high temperatures were mostly in the lower 60s. Average lows were mostly in the 30s. There are abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included harvesting cotton and soybeans.


