Agricultural News: Farming activities for the month of December included feeding hay and harvesting corn. Weather conditions have been rainy with a mix of warm and very cold temperatures. Pastures are muddy. The average high temperatures during the month of December were mostly in the upper 40s. The average low temperatures during the month of December were mostly in the upper 20s. Monthly precipitation amounts ranged between 3 to 6 inches. There are abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions in the State.
