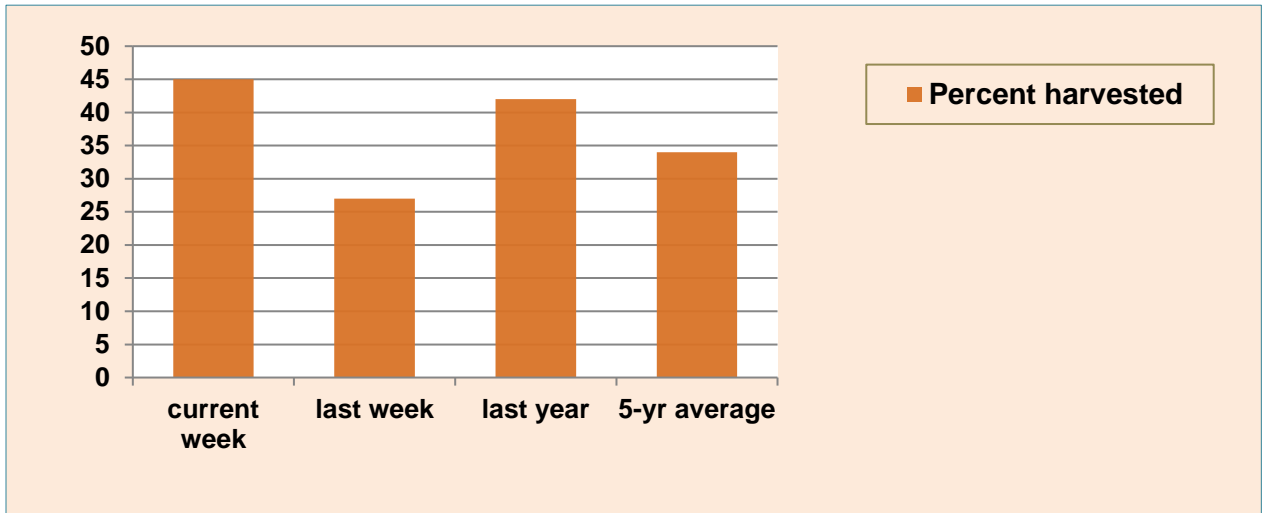

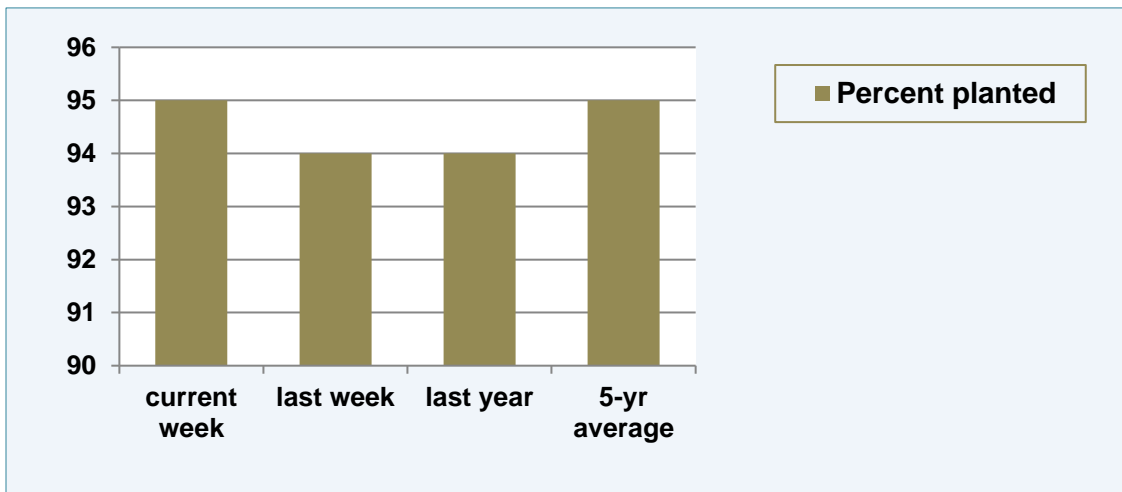

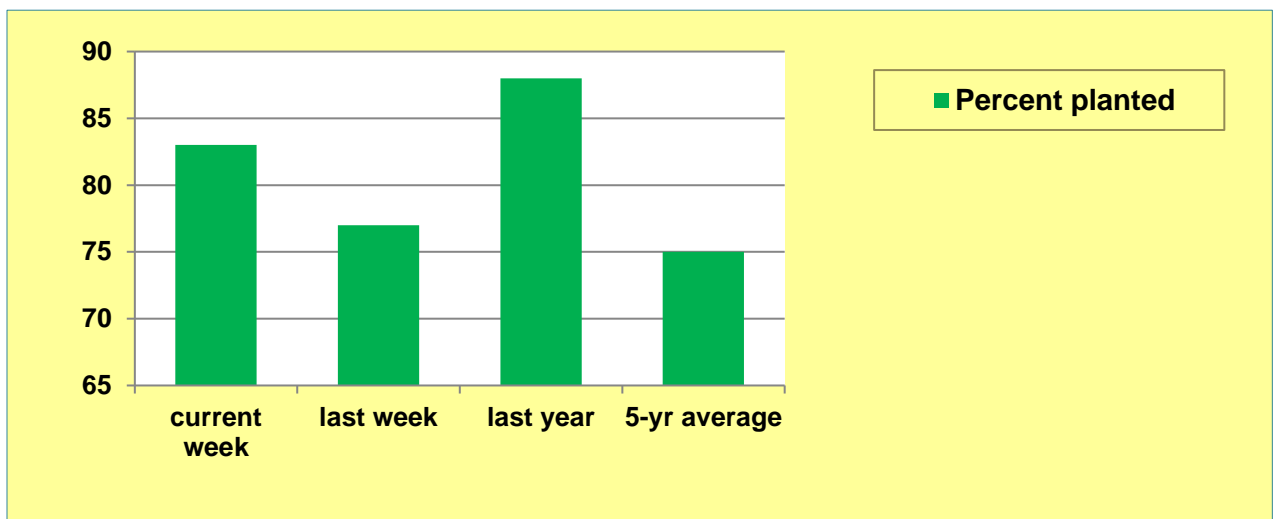
BARLEY HARVESTED FOR GRAIN for week ending 06/11/23
