
<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.6. Weather conditions were mostly cool with zero or limited rain. Average high temperatures were mostly in the lower 70s. There are abnormally dry to extreme drought conditions now in the State. Fields continue to dry up and farmers are feeding hay. Farming activities for the week included planting small grains, and harvesting cotton and soybeans.




