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
Agricultural News: This is the last weekly Virginia Crop Weather Bulletin of the year. Monthly reports will be published during the winter months. We would like to thank our federal, state and county cooperative partners for their valuable help in providing the information that makes this publication possible. Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.0. Weather conditions were mostly cool with rain. Average high temperatures were in the 50s. There are abnormally dry to extreme drought conditions in the State. Farmers are feeding hay. Farming activities for the week included planting wheat, and harvesting cotton and soybeans.






COTTON HARVESTED for week ending 11/26/23
