
<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 4.6. Weather conditions were warm and wet as remnants from Hurricane Helene continued bringing showers. Drier weather ended the week. Average high temperatures were mostly in the upper 70s. There are abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included calving and cleaning up from the flooding where houses, barns, and property were destroyed. Crops and livestock were lost as well.






APPLES HARVESTED for week ending 10/06/24
