
<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.9. Weather conditions were cool and very dry, with no precipitation. Conditions are good for harvesting crops, but not for germination. Average high temperatures were mostly in the lower 70s. There are abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included harvesting apples, corn for grain, cotton, peanuts, and soybeans.






APPLES HARVESTED for week ending 11/03/24
