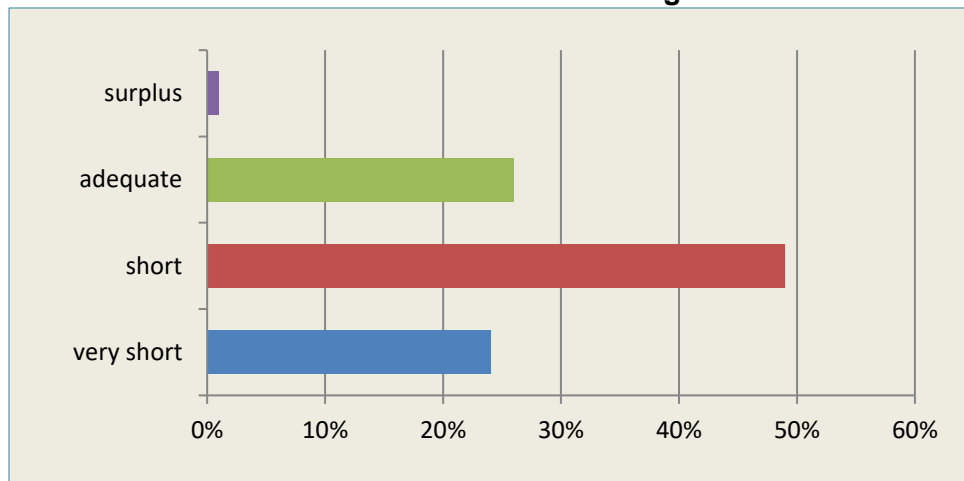
Agricultural News: Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.6. Weather conditions were cool and dry, with some precipitation. Pastures continue to dry up and are turning brown. Average high temperatures were mostly in the lower 70s. There are abnormally dry to severe drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included fall calving and harvesting cotton and soybeans.

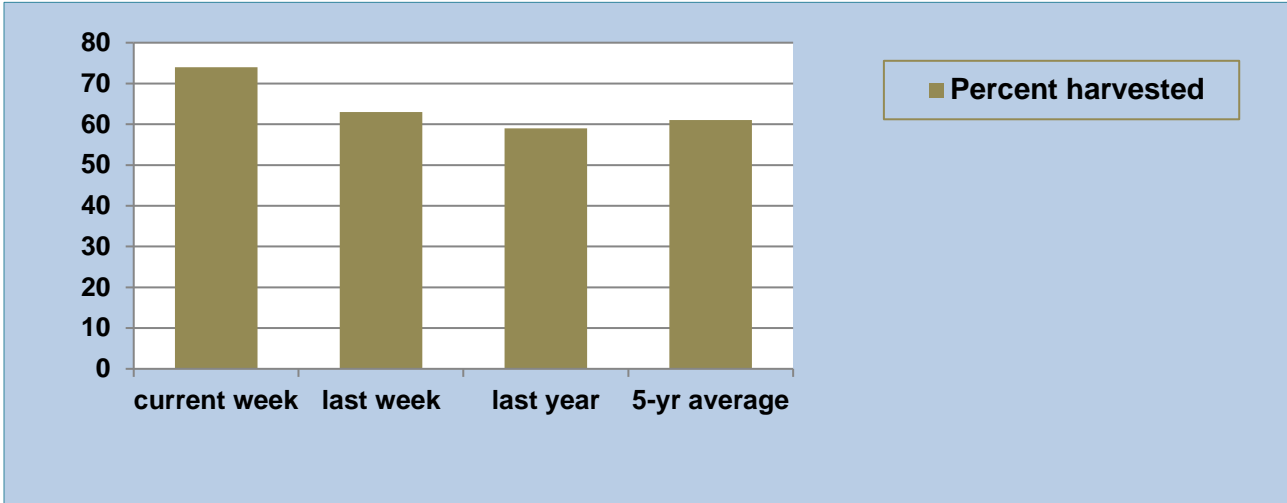

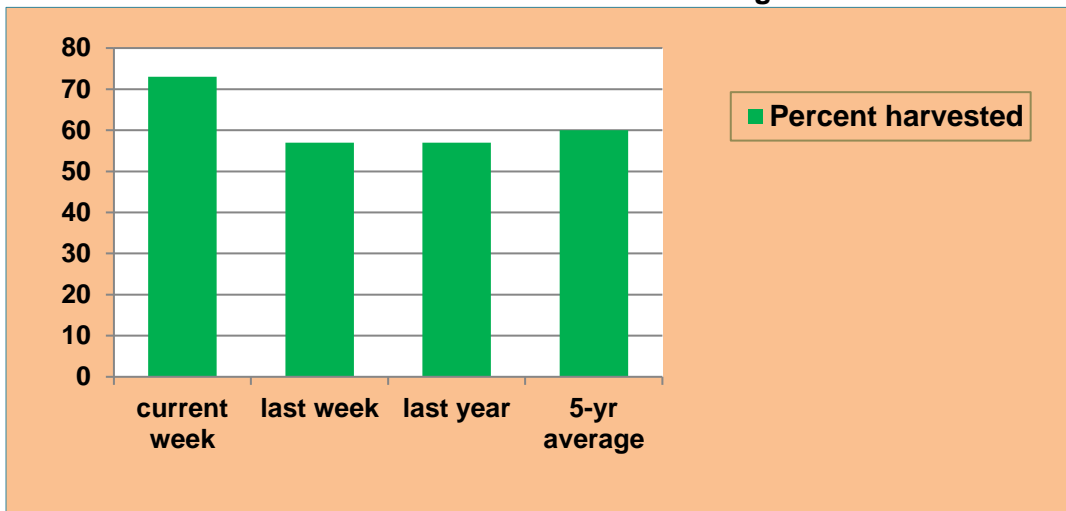

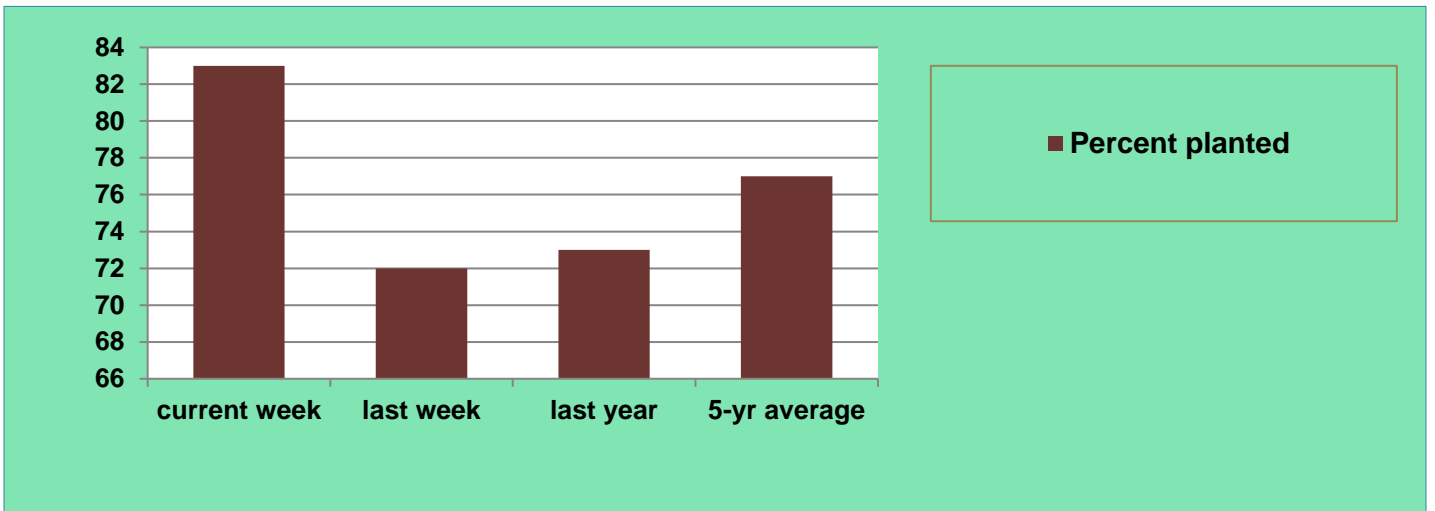
COTTON HARVESTED for week ending 11/10/24
