
<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 6.2. Weather conditions were warm with rain. Average high temperatures were in the lower 80s. Farming activities for the week included picking strawberries, planting corn and soybeans, and preparing tobacco fields. There are abnormally dry to severe drought conditions in the State. The lack of moisture is a concern to some farmers for seed germination.






CORN PLANTED for week ending 5/04/25
