The average price received by farmers for **corn** during March 2025 in Wisconsin was \$4.39 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service - Agricultural Prices report. This was 12 cents below the February price but 30 cents above March 2024.

The March 2025 average price received by farmers for soybeans, at \$9.71 per bushel, was 20 cents below the February price and \$1.89 below the March 2024 price.

The March average oat price per bushel, at \$4.10, was 28 cents above February and 22 cents above March 2024.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$122.00 per ton in March. This was \$2.00 below the February price and \$15.00 below the March 2024 price. The March 2025 alfalfa hay price, at \$132.00, was \$4.00 below the previous month and \$55.00 below March 2024. The average price received for other hay during March was \$90.00 per ton. This was \$11.00 above the February price but \$47.00 below March last year.

The average price for milk was \$21.80 per cwt, \$1.90 below the February price but \$2.60 above March 2024. Prices received for milk cows for dairy herd replacement averaged \$3,130 per head as of April 1, 2025.


